Sweater

NECKBAND

Sweater is worked in one piece from the neck down.

With circular knitting needle, cast on 48 sts.

Rows 1 and 2: Knit across.

Row 3 (Buttonhole row - Girl): Knit across to last 3 sts, YO (*Fig. 6a, page 23*), K2 tog (*Fig. 2, page 22*), K1.

Row 3 (Buttonhole row - Boy): K1, K2 tog (*Fig. 2, page 22*), YO (*Fig. 6a, page 23*), knit across.

Row 4: K 11, place marker (Right Front), (*see Markers, page 21*), K5 (Right Sleeve), place marker, K 16 (Back), place marker, K5 (Left Sleeve), place marker, K 11 (Left Front).

YOKE

Row 1 (Right side - Increase row): K8, increase (*Figs. 1a & b, page 22*), (K4, increase) across to last 9 sts, K9: 55 sts.

Row 2: K5, purl across to last 5 sts, K5.

Row 3 (Increase row): ★ Knit across to within one st of next marker, YO, K1, slip marker, K1, YO; repeat from ★ 3 times **more**, knit across: 63 sts.

Rows 4-12: Repeat Rows 2 and 3, 4 times; then repeat Row 2 once **more**: 95 sts.

Row 13 (Buttonhole row - Girl): ★ Knit across to within one st of next marker, YO, K1, slip marker, K1, YO; repeat from ★ 3 times **more**, knit across to last 3 sts, YO, K2 tog, K1: 103 sts.

Row 13 (Buttonhole row - Boy): K1, K2 tog, YO, ★ knit across to within one st of next marker, YO, K1, slip marker, K1, YO; repeat from ★ 3 times **more**, knit across: 103 sts.

Rows 14-26: Repeat Rows 2 and 3, 6 times; then repeat Row 2 once **more**: 151 sts.

Row 27 (Buttonhole row - Girl): Repeat Row 13: 159 sts.

Row 27 (Buttonhole row - Boy): Repeat Row 13: 159 sts.

Rows 28 and 29: Repeat Rows 2 and 3: 167 sts.

Dividing Row: K5, P 21 (Right Front), remove marker, place point protector on right hand point of circular needle, with empty straight needle, P 34 (Right Sleeve), remove marker and place point protector on remaining point of circular needle.

RIGHT SLEEVE

Row 1: Using straight knitting needles, K4, increase, (K1, increase) across to last 5 sts, K5: 47 sts.

Row 2 (Decrease row): K2, [P3 tog (*Fig. 3, page 22*), K2] across: 29 sts.

Row 3 (Increase row): P2, ★ YO (*Fig. 6c, page 23*), K1, YO (*Fig. 6b, page 23*), P2; repeat from ★ across: 47 sts.

Row 4: K2, (P3, K2) across.

Row 5: P2, (K3, P2) across.

Rows 6-30: Repeat Rows 2-5, 6 times; then repeat Row 2 once **more**: 29 sts.

Rows 31-35: Knit across.

Bind off all sts **loosely** in **knit**.

Dividing Row: Remove point protectors and P 47 (Back), remove marker, place point protector on right hand point of circular needle, with empty straight needle, P 34 (Left Sleeve), remove marker and place point protector on remaining point of circular needle.

LEFT SLEEVE

Complete same as Right Sleeve.

Dividing Row: Remove point protectors and P 21, K5 (Left Front): 99 sts.

BODY

Row 1: K6, increase, (K1, increase) across to last 6 sts, K6: 143 sts.

Row 2 (Decrease row): K5, P3 tog, (K2, P3 tog) across to last 5 sts, K5: 89 sts.

Row 3 (Increase row): K5, YO, K1, YO, (P2, YO, K1, YO) across to last 5 sts, K5: 143 sts.

Row 4: K5, P3, (K2, P3) across to last 5 sts, K5.

Row 5: K8, P2, (K3, P2) across to last 8 sts, K8.

Rows 6-33: Repeat Rows 2-5, 7 times: 143 sts.

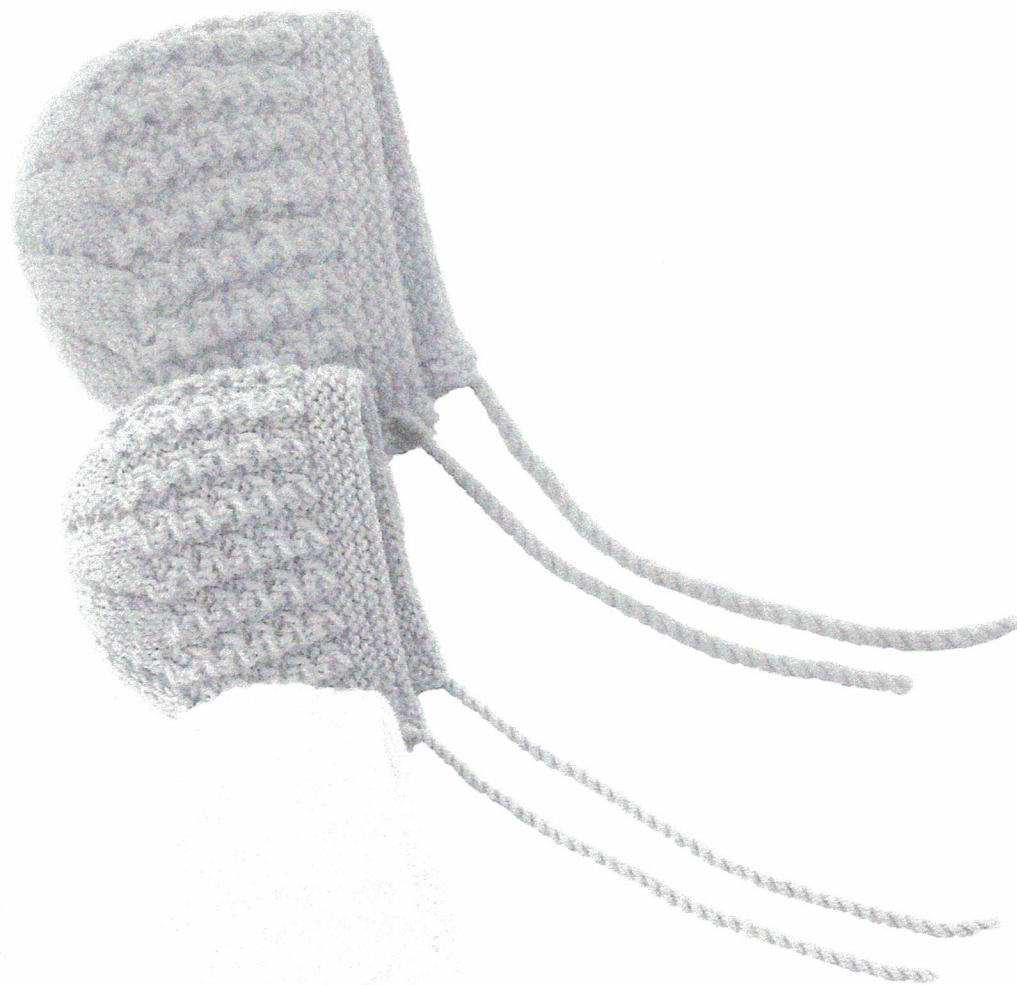
Row 34: K5, P3 tog, ★ increase, K1, P3 tog; repeat from ★ across to last 5 sts, K5: 115 sts.

Rows 35-39: Knit across.

Bind off all sts in **knit**.

Whipstitch underarm seams (*Fig. 8, page 23*).

Sew buttons to band opposite buttonholes.



Bonnet

CROWN

With straight knitting needles, cast on 8 sts.

Row 1 AND ALL WRONG SIDE ROWS: Purl across.

Row 2: K1, [YO (*Fig. 6a, page 23*), K1] across: 15 sts.

Row 4: K1, (YO, K2) across: 22 sts.

Row 6: K1, (YO, K3) across: 29 sts.

Row 8: K1, (YO, K4) across: 36 sts.

Row 10: K1, (YO, K5) across: 43 sts.

Row 12: K1, (YO, K6) across: 50 sts.

Row 14: K1, (YO, K7) across: 57 sts.

Row 16: K4, increase (*Figs. 1a & b, page 22*), (K1, increase) across to last 4 sts, K4: 82 sts.

BRIM

Row 1 (Decrease row): K2, [P3 tog (*Fig. 3, page 22*), K2] across: 50 sts.

Row 2 (Increase row): P2, ★ YO (*Fig. 6c, page 23*), K1, YO (*Fig. 6b, page 23*), P2; repeat from ★ across: 82 sts.

Row 3: K2, (P3, K2) across.

Row 4: P2, (K3, P2) across.

Rows 5-21: Repeat Rows 1-4, 4 times; then repeat Row 1 once **more**: 50 sts.

Rows 22-28: Knit across.

Bind off all sts **loosely** in **knit**.

Weave Crown seam (*Fig. 9a, page 24*).

NECKBAND

With **right** side facing and using straight knitting needles, pick up 40 sts evenly spaced along neck edge (*Fig. 7, page 23*).

Rows 1-4: Knit across.

Bind off all sts **loosely** in **knit**.

TIE (Make 2)

Cut one strand of yarn 4 yards (3.5 meters) long. Fold in half and fasten loop to a stationary object or have another person hold it; twist until tight. Fold in half again and let it twist upon itself, knot strand ends approximately 4" (10 cm) from end.

Thread needle with strand ends and sew one Tie to each corner of Bonnet.



Cap

Work same as Bonnet through Row 21 of Brim: 50 sts.

Bind off all sts **loosely** in **knit**.

Weave Crown seam (*Fig. 9a, page 24*); then whipstitch Brim seam (*Fig. 8, page 23*).



Blanket

MOTIF (Make 20)
Cast on 33 sts.

Rows 1-5: Knit across.

Row 6: K3, P3 tog (*Fig. 3, page 22*), ★ increase (*Figs. 1a & b, page 22*), P3 tog; repeat from ★ across to last 3 sts, K3: 25 sts.

Row 7 (Increase row): K3, YO (*Fig. 6a, page 23*), K1, YO (*Fig. 6b, page 23*), ★ P2, YO (*Fig. 6c, page 23*), K1, YO; repeat from ★ across to last 3 sts, K3: 39 sts.

Row 8: K3, P3, (K2, P3) 6 times, K3.

Row 9: K6, (P2, K3) 6 times, K3.

Row 10 (Decrease row): K3, P3 tog, (K2, P3 tog) 6 times, K3: 25 sts.

Rows 11-45: Repeat Rows 7-10, 8 times; then repeat Rows 7-9 once **more**: 39 sts.

Row 46: K3, P3 tog, (increase, K1, P3 tog) across to last 3 sts, K3: 31 sts.

Rows 47-51: Knit across.

Bind off all sts **loosely** in **knit**.

Using photo as a guide for placement, whipstitch Motifs together (*Fig. 8, page 23*), forming 4 vertical strips of 6 Motifs each; then whipstitch strips together in same manner.

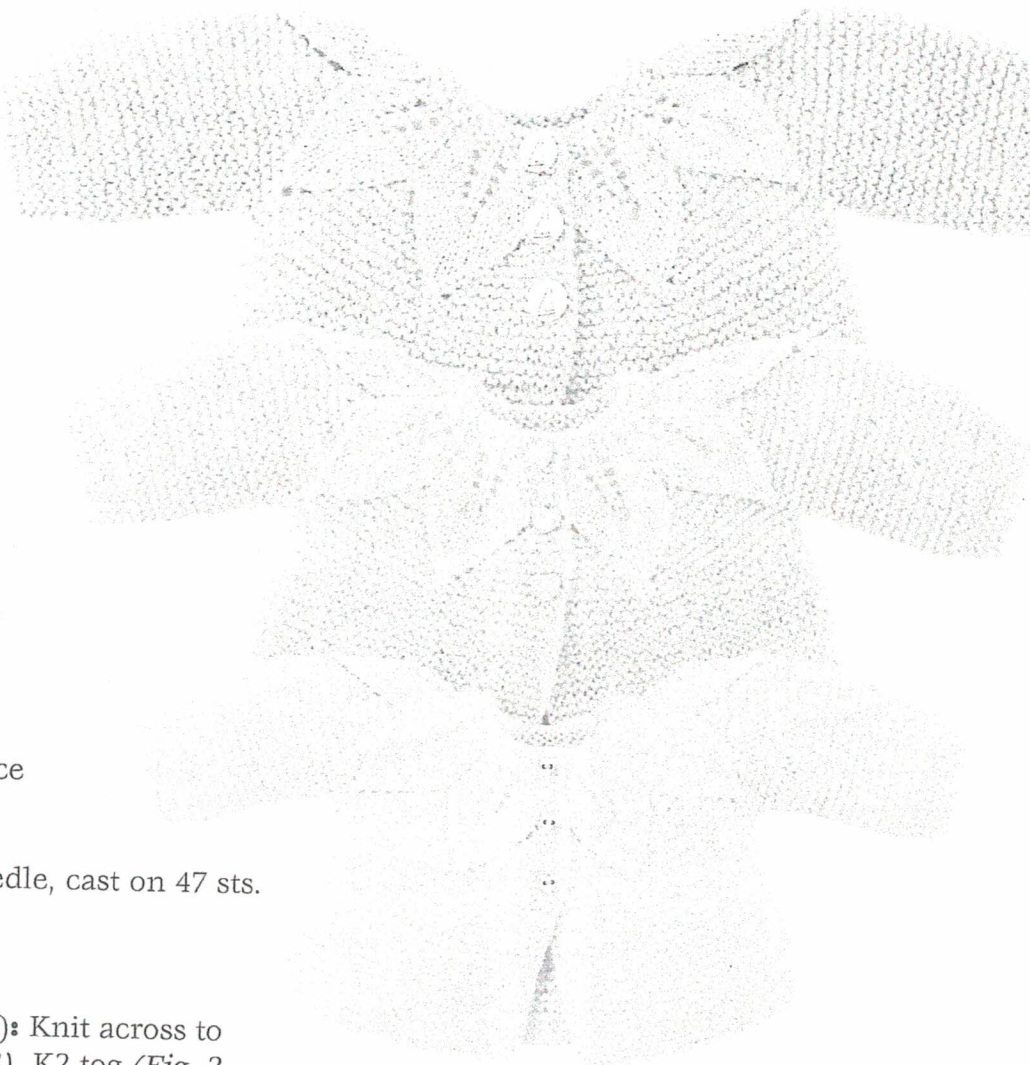

Sweater

YOKE

Sweater is worked in one piece from the neck down.

With smaller size circular needle, cast on 47 sts.

Rows 1 and 2: Knit across.

Row 3 (Buttonhole row - Girl): Knit across to last 3 sts, YO (*Fig. 6a, page 23*), K2 tog (*Fig. 2, page 22*), K1.

Row 3 (Buttonhole row - Boy): K1, K2 tog (*Fig. 2, page 22*), YO (*Fig. 6a, page 23*), knit across.

Rows 4 and 5: Knit across.

Row 6: K4, P3, (K1, P3) across to last 4 sts, K4.

Row 7 (Right side): K5, YO, K1, YO, (K3, YO, K1, YO) across to last 5 sts, K5: 67 sts.

Row 8: K4, P5, (K1, P5) across to last 4 sts, K4.

Row 9: K6, YO, K1, YO, (K5, YO, K1, YO) across to last 6 sts, K6: 87 sts.

Row 10: K4, P7, (K1, P7) across to last 4 sts, K4.

Row 11: K7, (YO, K1, YO, K7) across: 107 sts.

Row 12: K4, P9, (K1, P9) across to last 4 sts, K4

Row 13: K8, YO, K1, YO, (K9, YO, K1, YO) across to last 8 sts, K8: 127 sts.

Row 14: K4, P 11, (K1, P 11) across to last 4 sts, K4.

Row 15 (Buttonhole row - Girl): K9, YO, K1, YO (K 11, YO, K1, YO) across to last 9 sts. K6, YO (buttonhole), K2 tog, K1: 147 sts.

Row 15 (Buttonhole row - Boy): K1, K2 tog, YO (buttonhole), K6, YO, K1, YO, (K 11, YO, K1, YO) across to last 9 sts, K9: 147 sts.

Row 16: K3, increase (*Figs. 1a & b, page 22*), (P 13, increase) across to last 3 sts, K3: 158 sts.

Row 17: K5, YO, SSK (*Figs. 4a-c, page 22*), K9, K2 tog, YO, (K2, YO, SSK, K9, K2 tog, YO) across to last 5 sts, K5.

Row 18: K6, P 11, (K4, P 11) across to last 6 sts, K6.

Row 19: K6, YO, SSK, K7, K2 tog, YO, (K4, YO, SSK, K7, K2 tog, YO) across to last 6 sts, K6.

Row 20: K4, increase, K2, P9, (K2, increase, K3, P9) across to last 7 sts, K2, increase, K4: 169 sts.

Row 21: K8, YO, SSK, K5, K2 tog, YO, (K7, YO, SSK, K5, K2 tog, YO) across to last 8 sts, K8.

Row 22: K9, (P7, K9) across.

Row 23: K9, (YO, SSK, K3, K2 tog, YO, K9) across.

Row 24: K 10, P5, (K5, increase, K5, P5) across to last 10 sts, K 10: 178 sts.

Row 25: K 10, YO, SSK, K1, K2 tog, YO, (K 12, YO, SSK, K1, K2 tog, YO) across to last 10 sts, K 10.

Row 26: K 11, P3, (K 14, P3) across to last 11 sts, K 11.

Row 27 (Buttonhole row - Girl): K 11, YO, [slip 1, K2 tog, PSSO (*Figs. 5a & b, page 22*)], YO, ★ K 14, YO, slip 1, K2 tog, PSSO, YO; repeat from ★ across to last 11 sts, K8, YO (buttonhole), K2 tog, K1.

Row 27 (Buttonhole row - Boy): K1, K2 tog, YO (buttonhole), K8, YO, [slip 1, K2 tog, PSSO (*Figs. 5a & b, page 22*)], YO, ★ K 14, YO, slip 1, K2 tog, PSSO, YO; repeat from ★ across to last 11 sts, K 11.

Row 28: Knit across.

Change to larger size circular needle.

Rows 29-34: Knit across.

Dividing Row: K 29 (Left Front), place point protector on right hand point of circular needle, with empty larger size straight needle, K 34 (Left Sleeve), place point protector on remaining point of circular needle.

LEFT SLEEVE

Rows 1-27: Using larger size straight needles, knit across.

Change to smaller size straight needles.

Row 28: K4, (K2 tog, K3) across: 28 sts.

Rows 29-37: Knit across.

Bind off all sts **loosely in knit**.

Dividing Row: Remove point protectors and K 52 (Back), place point protector on right hand point of circular needle, with empty larger size straight needle, K 34 (Right Sleeve), place point protector on remaining point of circular needle.

RIGHT SLEEVE

Complete same as Left Sleeve.

Dividing Row: Remove point protectors and K 29 (Right Front): 110 sts.

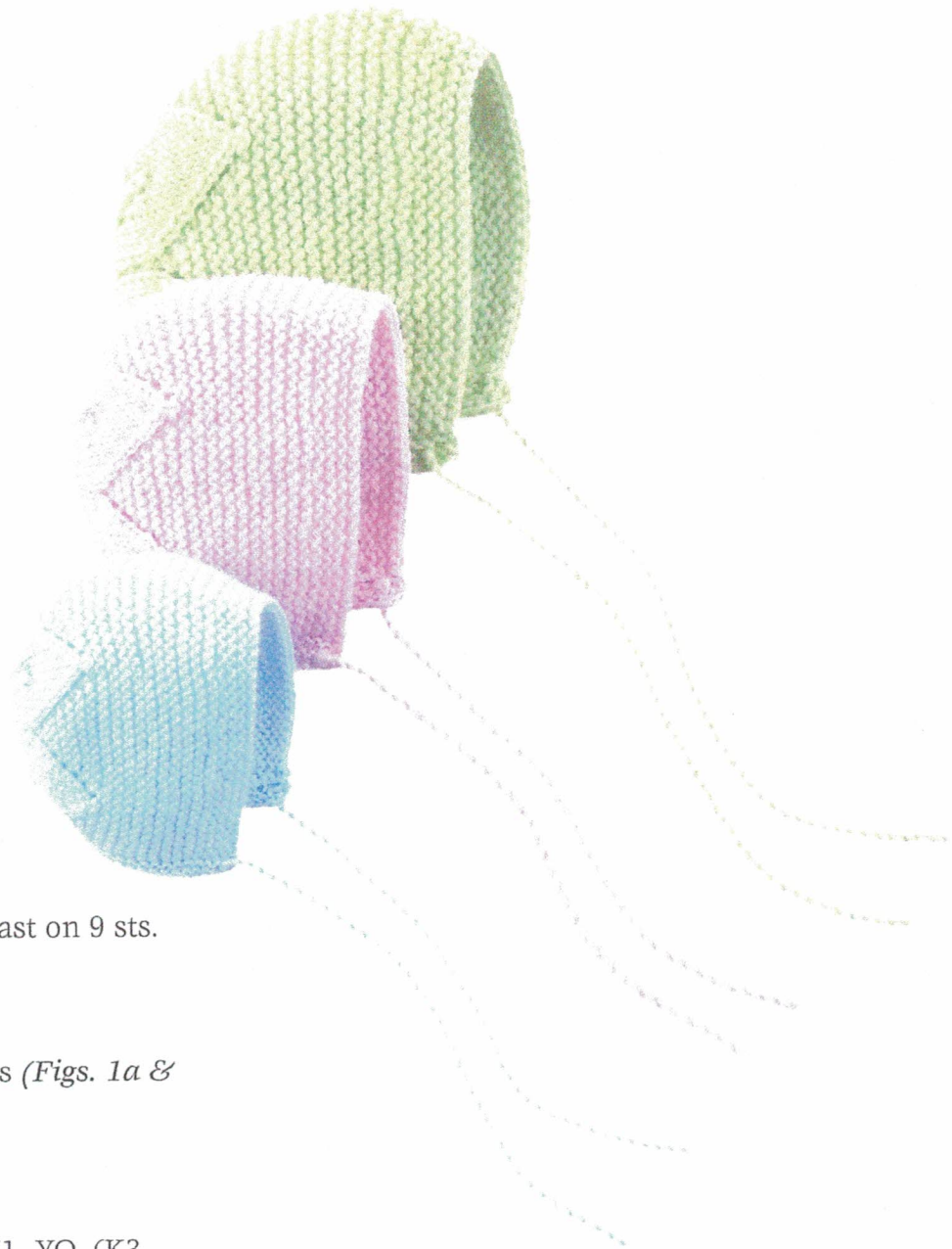
BODY

Rows 1-30: Knit across.

Bind off all sts **loosely in knit**.

Weave underarm seams (*Fig. 9b, page 24*).

Sew buttons to Front opposite buttonholes.



Bonnet

With smaller size straight needles, cast on 9 sts.

Row 1: Purl across.

Row 2 (Right side): Increase 8 times (*Figs. 1a & b, page 22*), K1: 17 sts.

Row 3: Purl across.

Row 4: K2, YO (*Fig. 6a, page 23*), K1, YO, (K3, YO, K1, YO) 3 times, K2: 25 sts.

Row 5: K1, (P5, K1) across.

Row 6: K3, YO, K1, YO, (K5, YO, K1, YO) 3 times, K3: 33 sts.

Row 7: K1, (P7, K1) across.

Row 8: K4, YO, K1, YO, (K7, YO, K1, YO) 3 times, K4: 41 sts.

Row 9: K1, (P9, K1) across.

Row 10: K5, YO, K1, YO, (K9, YO, K1, YO) 3 times, K5: 49 sts.

Row 11: K1, (P 11, K1) across.

Row 12: K6, YO, K1, YO, (K 11, YO, K1, YO) 3 times, K6: 57 sts.

Row 13: (Increase, P 13) 4 times, K1: 61 sts.

Mark each end of Row 13 for back seam.



Row 14: K1, ★ YO, SSK (*Figs. 4a-c, page 22*), K9, K2 tog (*Fig. 2, page 22*), YO, K2; repeat from ★ across.

Row 15: K3, P 11, (K4, P 11) 3 times, K2.

Row 16: K2, YO, SSK, K7, K2 tog, YO, ★ K4, YO, SSK, K7, K2 tog, YO; repeat from ★ 2 times **more**, K3.

Row 17: K4, P9, (K6, P9) 3 times, K3.

Row 18: K3, YO, SSK, K5, K2 tog, YO, ★ K6, YO, SSK, K5, K2 tog, YO; repeat from ★ 2 times **more**, K4.

Row 19: K5, P7, (K8, P7) 3 times, K4.

Row 20: K4, YO, SSK, K3, K2 tog, YO, ★ K8, YO, SSK, K3, K2 tog, YO; repeat from ★ 2 times **more**, K5.

Row 21: K6, P5, (K 10, P5) 3 times, K5.

Row 22: K5, YO, SSK, K1, K2 tog, YO, ★ K 10, YO, SSK, K1, K2 tog, YO; repeat from ★ 2 times **more**, K6.

Row 23: K7, P3, (K 12, P3) 3 times, K6.

Row 24: K6, YO, [slip 1, K2 tog, PSSO (*Figs. 5a & b, page 22*)], YO, ★ K 12, YO, slip 1, K2 tog, PSSO, YO; repeat from ★ 2 times **more**, K7.

Change to larger size straight needles.

Rows 25-45: Knit across.

Change to smaller size straight needles.

Row 46: Knit across.

Row 47: K1, (K2 tog, K4) across: 51 sts.

Rows 48-52: Knit across.

Bind off all sts **loosely in knit**.

Weave back seam from Row 1 to marked row (*Figs. 9a & b, page 24*).

NECK EDGING

With **right** side facing and using smaller size straight needles, pick up 42 sts evenly spaced along neck edge (*Fig. 7, page 23*).

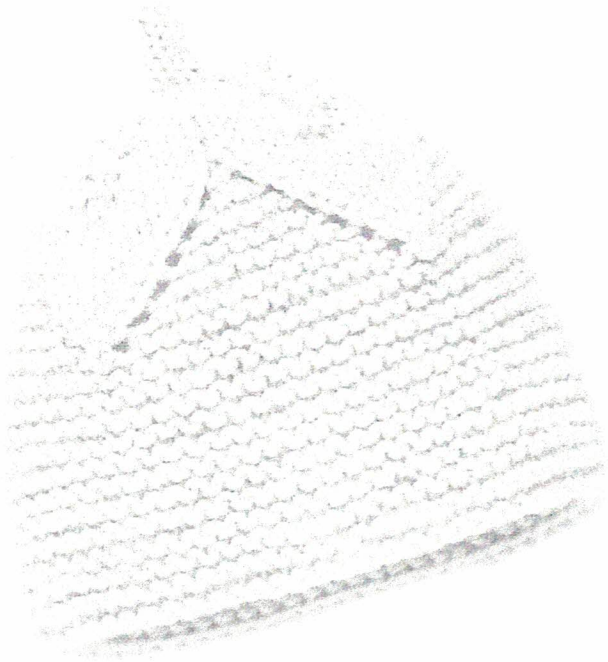
Rows 1-4: Knit across.

Bind off all sts **loosely in knit**.

TIE (Make 2)

Cut one strand of yarn 4 yards (3.5 meters) long. Fold in half and fasten loop to a stationary object or have another person hold it; twist until tight. Fold in half again and let it twist upon itself, knot strand ends approximately 4" (10 cm) from end.

Thread needle with strand ends and sew one Tie to each corner of Bonnet.



CAP

With smaller size straight needles, cast on 9 sts.

Row 1: Purl across.

Row 2 (Right side): Knit across.

Rows 3-7: Repeat Rows 1 and 2 twice, then repeat Row 1 once **more**.

Row 8: Increase 8 times (*Figs. 1a & b, page 22*), K1: 17 sts.

Row 9: Purl across.

Row 10: K2, YO (*Fig. 6a, page 23*), K1, YO, (K3, YO, K1, YO) 3 times, K2: 25 sts.

Row 11: K1, (P5, K1) across.

Row 12: K3, YO, K1, YO, (K5, YO, K1, YO) 3 times, K3: 33 sts.

Row 13: K1, (P7, K1) across.

Row 14: K4, YO, K1, YO, (K7, YO, K1, YO) 3 times, K4: 41 sts.

Row 15: K1, (P9, K1) across.

Row 16: K5, YO, K1, YO, (K9, YO, K1, YO) 3 times, K5: 49 sts.

Row 17: K1, (P 11, K1) across.

Row 18: K6, YO, K1, YO, (K 11, YO, K1, YO) 3 times, K6: 57 sts.

Row 19: (Increase, P 13) 4 times, K1: 61 sts.

Row 20: K1, ★ YO, SSK (*Figs. 4a-c, page 22*), K9, K2 tog (*Fig. 2, page 22*), YO, K2; repeat from ★ across.

Row 21: K3, P 11, (K4, P 11) 3 times, K2.

Row 22: K2, YO, SSK, K7, K2 tog, YO, ★ K4, YO, SSK, K7, K2 tog, YO; repeat from ★ 2 times **more**, K3.

Row 23: K4, P9, (K6, P9) 3 times, K3.

Row 24: K3, YO, SSK, K5, K2 tog, YO, ★ K6, YO, SSK, K5, K2 tog, YO; repeat from ★ 2 times **more**, K4.

Row 25: K5, P7, (K8, P7) 3 times, K4.

Row 26: K4, YO, SSK, K3, K2 tog, YO, ★ K8, YO, SSK, K3, K2 tog, YO; repeat from ★ 2 times **more**, K5.

Row 27: K6, P5, (K 10, P5) 3 times, K5.

Row 28: K5, YO, SSK, K1, K2 tog, YO, ★ K 10, YO, SSK, K1, K2 tog, YO; repeat from ★ 2 times **more**, K6.

Row 29: K7, P3, (K 12, P3) 3 times, K6.

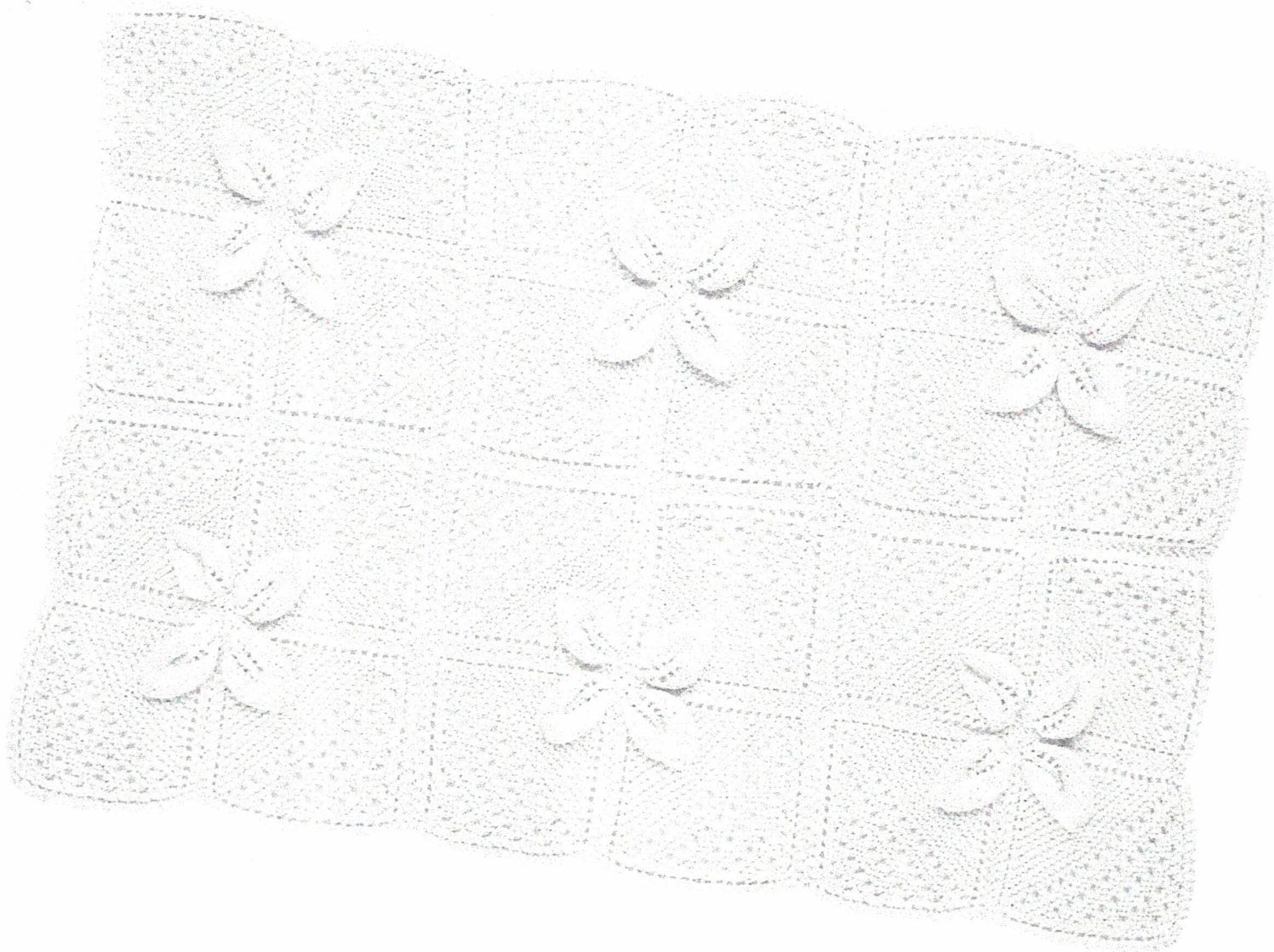
Row 30: K6, YO, [slip 1, K2 tog, PSSO (*Figs. 5a & b, page 22*)], YO, ★ K 12, YO, slip 1, K2 tog, PSSO, YO; repeat from ★ 2 times **more**, K7.

Change to larger size straight needles.

Rows 31-54: Knit across.

Bind off all sts **loosely in knit**.

Weave back seam (*Figs. 9a & b, page 24*).



BLANKET

MOTIF (Make 24)

With larger size straight knitting needles,
cast on 2 sts.

Row 1: Knit across.

Row 2 (Right side): Increase (*Figs. 1a & b, page 22*), K1: 3 sts.

Row 3: Knit across.

Row 4: Increase twice, K1: 5 sts.

Row 5: Knit across.

Row 6: K2, YO (*Fig. 6a, page 23*), K1, YO, K2:
7 sts.

Row 7: K2, P3, K2.

Row 8: K2, YO, (K1, YO) 3 times, K2: 11 sts.

Row 9: K3, P5, K3.

Row 10: K2, YO, K3, YO, K1, YO, K3, YO, K2:
15 sts.

Row 11: K4, P7, K4.

Row 12: K2, YO, K5, YO, K1, YO, K5, YO, K2:
19 sts.

Row 13: K5, P9, K5.

Row 14: K2, YO, K7, YO, K1, YO, K7, YO, K2:
23 sts.

Row 15: K6, P 11, K6.

Row 16: K2, YO, K9, YO, K1, YO, K9, YO, K2:
27 sts.

Row 17: K7, P 13, K7.

Row 18: K2, YO, K5, SSK (*Figs. 4a-c, page 22*),
K9, K2 tog (*Fig. 2, page 22*), K5, YO, K2.

Row 19: K8, P 11, K8.

Row 20: K2, YO, K6, SSK, K7, K2 tog, K6, YO, K2.

Row 21: K9, P9, K9.

Row 22: K2, YO, K7, SSK, K5, K2 tog, K7, YO, K2.

Row 23: K 10, P7, K 10.

Row 24: K2, YO, K8, SSK, K3, K2 tog, K8, YO, K2.

Row 25: K 11, P5, K 11.

Row 26: K2, YO, K9, SSK, K1, K2 tog, K9, YO, K2.

Row 27: K 12, P3, K 12.

Row 28: K2, YO, K 10, [slip 1, K2 tog, PSSO
(*Figs. 5a & b, page 22*)], K 10, YO, K2.

Row 29: Knit across.

Row 30: K2, YO, knit across to last 2 sts, YO, K2:
29 sts.

Rows 31-38: Repeat Rows 29 and 30, 4 times:
37 sts.

Row 39: K4, (YO, K2 tog) across to last 3 sts, K3.

Row 40 (Decrease row): K1, K2 tog, YO, K2 tog,
knit across to last 5 sts, K2 tog, YO, K2 tog, K1:
35 sts.

Row 41: Knit across.

Rows 42-44: Repeat Rows 40 and 41 once, then
repeat Row 40 once **more:** 31 sts.

Rows 45-67: Repeat Rows 39-44, 3 times; then
repeat Rows 39-43 once **more:** 9 sts.

Row 68: K1, K2 tog, YO, slip 1, K2 tog, PSSO, YO,
K2 tog, K1: 7 sts.

Row 69: K3, K2 tog, K2: 6 sts.

Row 70: K1, K2 tog, YO, K2 tog, K1: 5 sts.

Row 71: Knit across.

Row 72: K1, slip 1, K2 tog, PSSO, K1: 3 sts.

Row 73: Slip 1, K2 tog, PSSO: one st.

Cut yarn and draw through last st.

Using photo as a guide for placement,
whipstitch Motifs together (*Fig. 8, page 23*),
forming 4 vertical strips of 6 Motifs each; then
whipstitch strips together in same manner.
